Schwartz currently serves as chairman of Guidepost Solutions, a global investigation, compliance, and security firm. He has served as a trial lawyer, corporate advisor and CEO of a private company and a unit of a public company. He also served as the Chief of the Criminal Division in the Southern District of New York. Schwartz is the author of numerous blogs and articles on compliance, monitoring, and investigations and he co-authored a chapter on investigations for

West Publications in the treatise Business and Commercial Litigation in Federal Courts. He frequently speaks at law and other conferences and has served as an expert witness.
