OVERVIEW

Angela J. Osborne, PCI, PSP specializes in emergency management planning, security risk assessments, and physical security assessments. While living in the United Arab Emirates (UAE), she established TAQA's Traveler/Expatriate Risk Management System, co-developed the TAQA High Risk Environment Awareness Training, and trained staff in security strategies on three continents. Ms. Osborne facilitated expatriate duty of care initiatives, including vetting lodging options, evaluating local security support, and preparing expatriates for international assignments in high risk areas. She has worked in Canada, Egypt, Ghana, India, Iraq, Malaysia, Singapore, the UAE, and the United Kingdom.
